#### Photography Competition and Salon Information

In the December issue I listed a number of National photography competitions and salons that photographers are able to enter this year. Below are details on opening and closing dates that have become available since December.

#### 46th Warragul National Competition and Exhibition, 2019

#### **Competition Dates:**

Entries open early January 2019

Entries close 27th March 2019

Judging will be on 6th April 2019

Results emailed by 24th April 2019

#### Exhibition:

Friday 17th May to Monday 20th 10am to 4pm daily, Warragul Downtowner, Warragul. Victoria

This national competition has been increasing markedly in popularity. It is approved by APS and therefore acceptances count towards APS Honours. Entry will be online via the web site.

There is a large awards pool of over \$5,000 in cash and prizes. We are grateful to all our sponsors for their generous support.

As well as various sections in both Print and Digital we are also featuring, for the first time, a large prints section. These prints will require 500x700mm mats, suitable for prints on A2 paper. (Please ensure prints are posted in time to arrive by the closing date.)

#### The Moran Photographic Prize 2019

Entries open on 16 January and close on 6 March 2019 (for photos taken between 8 March 2018 and 6 March 2019).

A total prize pool of \$100,000 will be on offer for adults and school students.

We'll award photographers who portray the best snapshot of life in Australia; places, people and lifestyle that make our lovable country quintessentially Australian. It may be a landscape, portrait or action shot but above all else tell a story of how you experience living in Australia (NB. Photos do not need to be portraits).

#### 13TH FIAP WORLD CUP RESULTS FOR AUSTRALIAN CLUBS

For the 13<sup>th</sup> year the FIAP has run an international competition for Photography clubs, receiving entries from all over the world. Only two clubs represented Australia in the world cup, **Norths Photographic Society** and **The Entrance Camera Club**, and both are N.S.W. clubs. There were 188 clubs from 37 countries entered in the competition, with a total of 3,760 images submitted.

The two clubs scored 18 points each, with a total of 11 acceptances for Norths Photographic Society placing them 17th, and with a total of 13th acceptances for The Entrance Camera Club placed 18th.

I an informed by David Spratt, the president of the Entrance Camera Club, that with this score last year, Norths would have been first and the Entrance would have been second overall.

#### Maitland International Salon of Photography.

Entries for Maitland International close on the 14th of January, so there is little time left to enter. Opening night is at the Maitland showground on February the 11th at 6:30 PM, and the exhibition is open to the public on February the 13th. The exhibit will later be displayed at the Maitland Regional Art Gallery, 230 High St., Maitland, from the 23rd of February to the 18th of April.

#### BREAKING NEWS. - The AUSTRALIAN CONCEPTUAL PHOTOGRAPHIC PRIZE

The Australian Photographic Society has just announced a new Photographic Prize unlike any previously seen in Australia, This a competition that is aimed at **conceptual photographers**. The competition opens for entries on the 8<sup>th</sup> of January 2019 and close on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of May. Finalists will be announced on the 30<sup>th</sup> of May. Entries must have been created during the 12 months prior to the closing date of the competition.

The winner of the ACPP 2019 will be awarded \$8,000 cash. The winner of the best entry by an APS Member will receive \$2,000 cash. If the winner of the ACPP 2019 is an APS Member then that entrant will receive both cash amounts – totaling \$10,000.
