lge's Courses 2023

The FCC is running two new courses on judging photographs in February, 2023 in Sydney, with more courses planned in regional NSW later in 2023.

"Photography Clubs around NSW are crying out for more judges who are skilled in analysing photographs and giving positive feedback" said Michelle Kennedy, President of the FCC. "One of the FCC highest priorities is to get new judging courses running early in 2023," she added.

The FCC is providing two different judging courses that meet the needs of photographers.

"What judges look for" is for people interested in why some photographs score higher than others. It will explain how judges evaluate the content, composition and technical elements of an image. This is a one-day course and costs \$80.

"Become a photographic judge" is for people interested in judging photography competitions in Clubs around NSW. This practical course will help new judges build the knowledge and skills they need to analyse images, give feedback and score images. It emphasises giving constructive feedback to help photographers make better images. This two-day course costs \$100.
