Special thanks to our Judges Don Dickins, Martin Regan, Don Munro, Dan Crowley and Barry Collier. The Interclub was a very positive end to 2022. Next year, the FCC has some major new initiatives coming your way.

At the Interclub Presentation we announced there would be some changes to the definitions for future FCC NSW Competitions. In particular, the Australian Landscape/Seascape, Nature and Creative definitions will be updated and include conditions specific to AI technology and filters introducing new elements to images. The FCC Committee will consider these changes at its first meeting in 2023, and we will do our best to get these updates out to Clubs before your meetings and competitions commence for 2023.

Next year is also the 70th Anniversary of the formation of the FCC. We'll be having a major event to celebrate the tremendous work that photographers and volunteers have done over the seven decades to help people across NSW to develop their photographic skills, to enjoy the pleasures of photography and to promote the photographic movement more generally.

In February 2023 we'll be holding a brand new Photographic Judges Course. See page 3 for the latest information on another internationally-recognised photographer who is giving a presentation to the Course. We will also continue to develop new resources for the benefit of Clubs and their Members.

We hope everyone has a great break and enjoys the holiday season.

Judges Course

Award-winning photographer to present to Judging Conference

Internationally-recognised photographer, Meg Hewitt, will speak about how to make award-winning photographs at the FCC's "What Judges Look For" conference in February 2023.

Meg's international awards include a gold medal from the Tokyo International Foto Competition and a silver medal from the Prix de la Photographie, Paris. She was fringe artist of the year at the Ballarat International Foto Biennale and is a member of the Australian photo collective Oculi and the international street photography collective Up. Meg also has experience as a photographic judge, most recently as a judge for the 2022 Head On Awards.

"It's very exciting to have another internationally recognised photographer and photographic judge presenting at the FCC Judges Course," said Michelle Kennedy, President, FCC.

"Meg's insights into what modern judges are looking for in a photograph is directly relevant to all photographers," Michelle added.

"Meg's experience, plus that of the 2022 Mullins Conceptual Photography Prize judge, Bill Bachman, will bring FCC members up-to-date with judging best practice for Club, national and international competitions," she said.

Meg is looking forward to sharing her experience at the FCC course.

"When I started off making pictures I worked from a distance exploring composition and form in space. As time went on I felt I wanted to engage more with the world and also explore how people feel and how things connect us," said Meg.

"Rules are meant to be broken, that's when we grow in our work," she said.

The "What Judges Look For" conference takes place on Saturday 25 February, 2023 at Rydges Parramatta. It is open to all FCC members, and costs \$80. Payment includes the cost of presenters, lunch and refreshments, and a workbook.

People interested in becoming an FCC photographic judge need to attend the "What Judges Look For" conference on 25 February plus the "What Judges Do" course on Sunday 26 February. The two-day course costs \$100.

The FCC plans to run a similar program in regional NSW later in 2023 and in future years.
